

## JANE:TERZIAN PROJECTS

Andrzej Zielinski, "Object Possession"

JANE:TERZIAN PROJECTS is pleased to present a selection of eight paintings and four drawings by Berlin based artist Andrzej Zielinski. The show will open on Saturday, September 28 with a reception from 5-8pm and close on Saturday, November 2.

In "Object Possession", Zielinski provides the viewer with familiar subject matter - cell phones, fax machines, and copiers – but conveys the image through a densely saturated veil of color and generous layers of acrylic paint, a technique in which the paintings themselves allow the unconscious object to express itself. He renders these objects with vivid layers of impastoed acrylic, at a 1:1 scale - but all relationship to reality ends there. The cell phone exists in a supercharged atmosphere of color and texture, at odds with traditional imagery and reimagined with such physicality, suggesting a three dimensional object. This aesthetic dislocation is Zielinski's brilliant way of capturing the phenomena of communication as we know it today in an indertiminable image, swathed in Technicolor.

The roving curatorial team Jane:Terzian Projects is the partnership of artist Jessica Jane, and art consultant Jennifer Terzian. They have appropriated an artist's studio for use as a temporary gallery, converting this largely unfinished room in the Bantam Switch Factory into an exhibition space for the duration of the show. The traditional gallery space, a familiar portal to viewing art, is turned on its head, and the place of production becomes a space for exhibition. "My studio is not usually open to the public – it is more of a refuge for me. But it is also a perfect flex space for different kinds of events. I'm honored and excited to have Andrzej Zielinski's work here next month," says Jessica Jane.

Andrzej Zieliński was born in Kansas City, Missouri. He received his BFA from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago and his MFA from Yale University. His work has been shown in New York City, Los Angeles, Berlin, Tokyo, and Sydney. Andrzej Zieliński's work is in the collections of the Portland Art Museum, The Nerman Museum of Contemporary Art, Canberra Museum and Art Gallery, and the National Gallery of Australia. He lives and works in Berlin, Germany.
